MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04-2018

ORDINANCE SETTING FOR CURFEW HOURS FOR MINORS FROM  
 P.M. TO 5:00 A.M., PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS  
 VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Sponsored by Hon. Bernie A. Ortiz and Hon. Rebecca L. Reyes

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of the Philippine Constitution  
 es that:

"The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and  
 promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social  
 being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism, and nationalism, and  
 encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs".

WHEREAS, it is necessary in the interest of public order and safety  
 regulate the movement of minor children during night time by setting  
 primary hours, protect them from neglect, abuse, cruelty and exploitation,  
 other conditions prejudicial or detrimental to their development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN  
 REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known as the  
 New Ordinance of Carmona, Cavite".

SECTION 2. CURFEW HOURS. - The curfew hours shall be effective from  
 P.M. every night up to 5:00 A.M. the next morning.

**SECTION 3. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES/OFFENSES. -**

- a. All minor children are prohibited to roam around, loiter, wander, stay, meander or stroll in all public places during curfew hours - 10:00 PM every night up to 5:00 A.M. the next morning - whether singly or in groups without lawful purpose or justifiable reason.
- b. It is unlawful for a parent or guardian or person having custody over the minor to knowingly permit or by insufficient control allow the minor to remain in any public place within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Carmona, Cavite during curfew hours.

**SECTION 4. EXEMPTIONS. -** Minor children under the following circumstances shall not be covered by the provisions of this Ordinance:

- a. Those accompanied by their parents or guardian or those having legal custody over the minor;
- b. Those on their way to or from a party, graduation ceremony, religious mass, and/or other extra-curricular activities of their school or organization, or those who are out and unable to go home early due to circumstances beyond their control as verified by the proper authorities concerned;

- c. Those attending to, or in experience of, an emergency situation such as encounter, and similar incidents; or
- d. When the minor is engaged in a lawful and authorized employment activity, or going to or returning home from the same place of employment activity, without any detour or stop.

**SECTION 5. OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITY OF PARENT/S, GUARDIAN/S, AND/OR CUSTODIAN. -** The parent/s, guardian/s, and/or custodian/s who are in actual custody or living together with the minor child are hereby mandated to supervise the conduct and activities of their minor children and see to it that the latter are already in their home prior to and until after the curfew hours.

**SECTION 6. PENALTIES AND MANNER OF DEALING WITH THE VIOLATOR. -**

The following penalties shall be imposed for violation of the provisions of this Ordinance:

**a. For the 1st OFFENSE -**

The minor found violating this Ordinance for the first time will be referred to the nearest Barangay hall or police station. The Punong Barangay or any of the Barangay Councilors shall conduct the counseling before the minor will be properly turned over to his/her parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s.



The parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s of the minor in violation of this Ordinance shall be summoned to fetch the minor from the barangay hall or police station; prior to turn over of the minor, the parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s will be informed of the consequences they will be dealing with in case of subsequent violation of the minor pursuant to the applicable provisions under this Ordinance.

Further, the parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s of the minor shall pay a penalty of fine amounting to ONE THOUSAND PESOS (₱1,000.00), or render TWELVE (12) HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE.

**b. For the 2nd OFFENSE -**

The minor found violating this Ordinance for the second time will be required to attend, together with his/her parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s, counseling sessions to be conducted by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development (MSWD); PROVIDED, that the social worker conducting the counseling shall certify compliance or non-compliance by the concerned minor and his/her parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s with this penalty; PROVIDED, FURTHER, that the minor and/or his/her parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s shall be required to submit the certification issued by the social worker to the Punong Barangay and the apprehending officer within a period not to exceed two (2) months from date of violation.

Further, the parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s of the minor shall pay a penalty of fine amounting to ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (₱1,500.00), or render TWENTY FOUR (24) HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE.

**c. For the 3rd and every subsequent OFFENSE -**

The minor found violating this Ordinance for the third time

and every time for the preceding violation shall be required to attend the intervention programs as prescribed under the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006 or Republic Act No. 9344.

Further, the parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s of the minor shall pay a penalty of fine amounting to ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (₱1,500.00), or render TWENTY FOUR (24) HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE.

The Barangay concerned in the implementation of this Ordinance shall keep a separate record for the proper monitoring of the violations. The foregoing records shall at all times remain confidential.

**PROCEDURE.** - The provisions of Section 21 of Republic Act No. 9344, otherwise known as the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006, shall be applied supplementarily in dealing with minors found to be in violation of this Ordinance.

The minor found violating this Ordinance for the third time thereafter, in addition to the counseling prescribed under Section 21 of Republic Act No. 9344, shall be required to undergo intervention programs as prescribed under the provisions of the *Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006*.

Further, the parent/s, guardian/s, or custodian/s of the minor shall pay a penalty of fine amounting to TWO THOUSAND PESOS (₱2,500.00), or render THIRTY SIX (36) HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE.

The Barangay concerned in the implementation of this Ordinance shall keep a separate record for the proper monitoring of the violations. The foregoing records shall at all times remain confidential.


**SECTION 7. ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURE.** - The provisions of Section 21 of Republic Act No. 9344, otherwise known as the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006, shall be applied supplementarily in dealing with minors found to be in violation of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All ordinances, executive orders, rules and regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof found to be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.

**SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** – This Ordinance shall take effect after the lapse of (10) days from the date of publication in a newspaper of local circulation or at the end of the posting period in two (2) conspicuous places in the Municipal Hall and in every barangay of this municipality.


